I wish both the MPH and MHA pass-outs all success in their future endeavors!

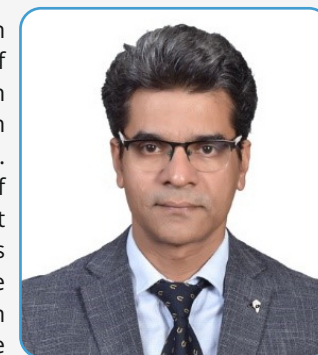

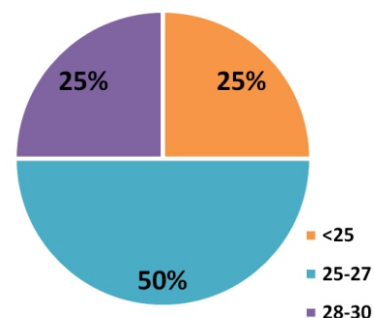

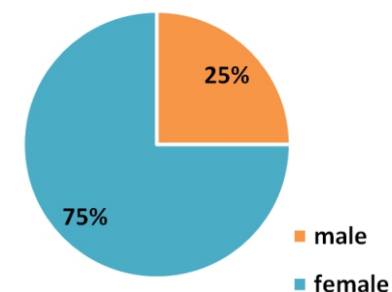

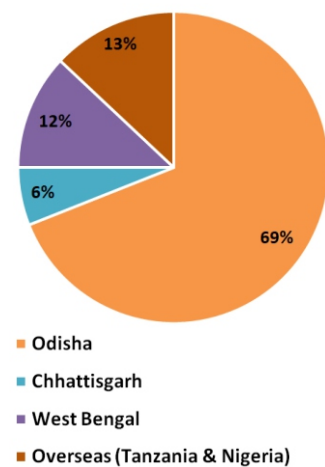
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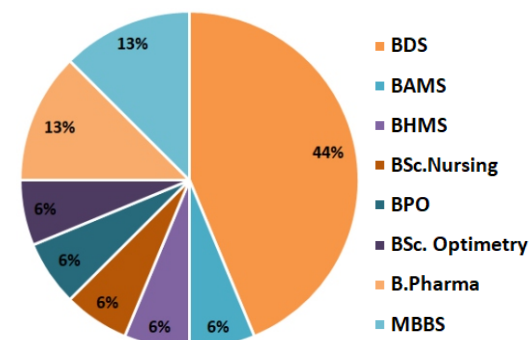
Gender Distribution
