It enables researchers to explore questions that cannot be easily quantified, facilitating a better understanding of complex human experiences. The workshop aims to introduce fundamental qualitative research methods, focusing on the concept of qualitative research, research methods, data collection techniques, qualitative data analysis, and interpretation. Participants will also gain practical experience in qualitative data management and analysis using the software, *Atlas.ti*.

- Formulate qualitative research questions
- Develop different types of qualitative data collection tools
- Develop skills to collect qualitative data, manage, analyze, interpret and present qualitative data
- Solution Use computer assisted qualitative data analysis package (*Atlas.ti*) to manage, analyze and interpret qualitative data
